2011 Center Of Effort Chardonnay Edna Valley

The 2011 Chardonnay is gorgeous. Aged 22 months in 45% new French oak, it offers up impressive orchard fruit, tangerine, distinct minerality and plenty of toast and spice notes to go with a medium to full-bodied, rich, layered and pure style. It has vibrant, yet integrated acidity, and stays nicely focused and clean on the finish. It's a serious value and will drink nicely over the coming 2-4 years.

In the same ballpark, the 2012 Chardonnay is a rich, soft and textured white that has classic white peach, citrus blossom, brioche and plenty of toasty notes to go with a medium-bodied, clean and forward feel. Drink it over the coming vear or two.

Leading off the reds, the 2011 Pinot Noir is beautiful wine that makes the most of the vintage. Possessing a darker, earthier slant, with black cherry, Asian spice and toast, it's medium-bodied, rich and nicely concentrated on the palate. It's an outstanding Pinot Noir to drink over the coming 3-5 years.

2012 Center Of Effort Pinot Noir Edna Valley

Similarly styled, yet slightly more fresh and fruit forward, the 2012 Pinot Noir spent 19 months in 35% new French oak, with the balance in neutral barrels. It gives up impressive currants, spring flowers and underbrush in its medium-bodied, supple and layered palate. The 2011 has a more classical feel, but I love the fruit and purity here. It should be consumed over the coming 3-5 years as well.
